PROJECT ELIGIBILITY AND CONTACT PERSON

- Name of school or registered charity and mailing address
- Charity registration number with the Canada Revenue Agency, if applicable
- Name of school, school board or registered charity that the cheque should be written to, if the project is selected for a prize
- Name of contact person, their job title or role and their contact information
- How did you hear about the Desjardins Foundation Prizes?

ABOUT THE PROJECT

- Project name
- Grade level of students involved
- Date the project will be carried out
This is the date the money you're applying for will be used. The money must be used between January 1 and December 31, 2022.

PROJECT FINANCING

- How much financial assistance would you like to receive through the Desjardins Foundation Prizes?
You can get a maximum of \$3,000.

Describe in more detail why you need this financial assistance. What will it be spent on? For example, \$300 will be used for decorating the space, \$300 for buying materials for the activity, \$100 to bring in a motivational speaker, etc.
- What is the total cost of the project?
The total cost of the project cannot be less than the amount requested.
