



## CONTEST "Take your shot"

### Competition rules

#### CONTEST DURATION

The Take your shot contest (the "Contest") is organized by the Desjardins, Sponsorships and Experiential Marketing Department (the "Contest Organizer") and runs from Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 9: 00 a.m. (EDT) to Thursday, June 25, 2026, at noon (EDT) (the "Contest Period").

#### ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to anyone who:

- Are 18 or older on April 15, 2026;
- Residing in Canada;
- Member<sup>1</sup> Desjardins .

(hereinafter the "Eligible Persons")

#### Exclusions

The Contest is not open to:

- Employees, managers and directors of Desjardins's Member / client Experience, Cooperation and Human Transformation Executive Division, members of their immediate families (siblings, children, parents), their legal or common-law spouses or persons with whom they reside;
- Employees, managers and directors of the Fédération des caisses Desjardins du Québec, Caisse Desjardins Ontario Credit Union Inc., the Fédération des caisses Desjardins Group entity, members of their immediate families (siblings, children, parents), their legal or common-law spouses or persons with whom they reside;
- Employees, managers, officers and directors of agencies and / or service businesses that participated in organizing this contest, members of their immediate families (siblings, children, parents), their legal or common-law spouses or persons with whom they reside;

#### HOW TO PARTICIPATE

During the Contest Period, Eligible Entrants must:

- Complete the entry form with the required information.;
- Submit their entry by noon (EDT) on June 25, 2026.

**No purchase or consideration required.** To enter the Contest without purchase or consideration, Eligible Entrants must write an email with their first and last name, their address including city and postal code, their telephone number, answer the following mathematical question  $8 \times (12 - 4) + 6 =$  and enter who they would like to be accompanied by at home on the evening of the game and send the email to [concours.desjardins@desjardins.com](mailto:concours.desjardins@desjardins.com). Emails must be sent no later than noon (EDT) on June 25, 2026. Upon receipt of the email, the Eligible Entrant's entry in the contest will be automatically registered and will give them a chance to win a prize. Only one participation per email owner. All such entries will be subject to the same terms and conditions as other entries. Entries are the property of the Contest Organizer and will not be returned.

Limit one (1) entry per Eligible Entrant, regardless of entry method used.

## PRICE

The prizes awarded during the playoffs in which the Montreal Canadiens participate are:

- Two (2) tickets to the Club Desjardins section at the Bell Centre for one of the home games scheduled for the playoffs with access to the Desjardins Lounge this evening. For the first round, the value of a ticket is six hundred and sixty-one (\$661). The total value of the tickets is one thousand three hundred and twenty-two (\$1,322). For the second round, the ticket's unit value is eight hundred twenty-four (\$824). The total value of the tickets is one thousand six hundred and forty-eight (\$1648). For the third round, the value of a ticket is one thousand one hundred and forty-nine (\$1149) per ticket. The total value of the tickets is two thousand two hundred and ninety-eight (\$2298). For the fourth round, the value of a ticket is one thousand one hundred and forty-nine (\$1,832). The total value of the match tickets is three thousand six hundred and sixty-four (\$3664)

Once the playoffs have ended, the Contest Organizer will award the following prize from among all Eligible Entrants:

- Two (2) tickets to the Club Desjardins section at the Bell Centre for the first home game for the 2026 – 2027 regular season of the Montreal Canadiens. The unit value of a ticket is five hundred and sixty-seven and twenty-two (\$567.22). The total value given for a game is one thousand one hundred and thirty-four and forty-four (1,134 \$ .44).

Anything not described above is not included in the prize and must be paid by the winner.

The winner, and not the Contest Organizer or the persons on whose behalf the Contest is held, is solely responsible for paying any taxes that may arise from the awarding of the prize.

The prize will be awarded through the online ticketing system for the Montreal Canadiens: Hotmaster.

The winner must refer to the suppliers' terms of use for the prize, and the Contest Organizer is not responsible for or related to these terms of use.

## SELECTION MODE

The winner will be selected through a computerized random draw.

The draw will be held at 9: 30 a.m. (EDT) the day before each game at home during the 2026 playoff period for the Montreal Canadiens, in the presence of witnesses, at the offices of the Contest Organizer located at 1 Complexe Desjardins, 16th floor, South Tower, Montreal, Quebec City, Canada, H5B 1B2.

Once the Montreal Canadiens have completed their 2026 playoffs, there will be a final draw on June 25, 2026, at 4: 00 p.m. (EDT) from all valid entries received during the contest period to win two (2) tickets to the Club Desjardins section at the Bell Centre for the first home game of the 2026 – 2027 regular Montreal Canadiens season. in the presence of witnesses, at the offices of the Contest Organizer located at 1 Complexe Desjardins, 16<sup>th</sup> floor, South Tower, Montreal, Quebec City, Canada, H5B 1B2.

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

To be declared a winner, each selected Eligible Entrant must:

- a) Be reached by telephone by a representative of the Contest Organizer within 2 hours (2 hours) of the draw. The selected Eligible Entrant must be reached within one (1) attempt and will have a maximum of four (4) hours to reply to the message left by the Contest Organizer, if applicable, failing which they will forfeit the prize. The prize will then be awarded to the next Eligible Entrant whose name will be drawn at random or according to the selection process defined herein and the same procedure will be followed until a winner is declared;
- b) Confirm that they have met the eligibility conditions and other requirements in these contest rules.;
- c) Have correctly answered, without help, a mathematical skill-testing question asked of them via the form or by email;
- d) Sign the declaration and release form (the "Declaration Form") sent to them by email. The Eligible Entrant must return it to the Organizer within two (2) business hours of receiving it.

Should the selected Eligible Entrant fail to meet any of the above-mentioned terms or any other condition in these contest rules, the Eligible Entrant will be disqualified and, at the Contest Organizer's discretion, the prize will be cancelled or a new draw will be held for the prize, in accordance with these contest rules, until an Eligible Entrant is selected and declared the winner. The same conditions will then apply, with any necessary modifications.

1. **Award ceremony.** Upon receipt of the Declaration Form, the Contest Organizer will inform the winner of how to claim the prize. If the winner refuses the prize, the Contest Organizer will be released from all obligations relating to the awarding of the prize to the selected Eligible Entrant and may, at its discretion, cancel the prize or hold a new draw in accordance with the procedure described above.
2. **Checks.** All entries and Declaration Forms may be subject to verification by the Organizer. Any entry that is incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, mechanically reproduced, mutilated, fraudulent, registered or submitted late, or that contains an invalid telephone number or is otherwise non-compliant may be rejected and will not entitle the Entrant to the prize.

5. **Identification of the eligible person.** Identification of the eligible person. For the purposes of these rules, the Eligible Entrant is the person whose name appears on the entry form and who meets the conditions set out in these rules. The prize will be awarded to the winner if they are selected and declared the winner. In the event of a dispute regarding the identification of the person who filled out the entry form, it will be considered to have been sent by the account holder associated with the email address provided at the time of entry, if applicable. "Account Holder" is defined as an individual who is assigned an email address by an internet provider or online service provider, or by another organization that assigns email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address.
6. **Price acceptance.** Prizes must be accepted as described in these contest rules and cannot, in any case, be transferred, in whole or in part, to anyone else, or exchanged and / or substituted for another prize, except as stipulated in these contest rules.
7. **Limitation of liability.** If the Contest Organizer is unable to award the prize as described herein, it reserves the right to award a similar prize of equal value or, at its sole discretion, to award the monetary value of the prize indicated herein. Under no circumstances will the Contest Organizer be required to award more prizes or to award a prize other than in accordance with these contest rules. If more prizes are offered than Eligible Entrants, the Organizer reserves the right to cancel the additional prizes.
8. **Limitation of liability: Use of prize.** The winner releases the Contest Organizer and the persons on whose behalf the Contest is held from any liability for damages that may arise from entering the Contest and from accepting or using the prize. The winner acknowledges that upon receipt of the prize by the Contest Organizer, fulfillment of scholarship-related obligations becomes the sole and exclusive responsibility of the product and service providers. The winner undertakes to sign a declaration and release form to this effect. The winner acknowledges that the only applicable warranty is the usual manufacturer's warranty.
9. **Limitation of liability: Contest operation.** The Organizer and the persons for whose benefit this Contest is held disclaim all liability with respect to the malfunction of any computer component, software or communication line, with respect to the loss or absence of network communication or with respect to any transmission that is faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or erased by any computer or computer network, and which may limit or prevent any person from reading the Contest rules. Furthermore, the Organizer cannot be held liable for any loss or damage that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by any web page, software or other download or by the transmission of any information concerning contest entry. More specifically, if the administration, security, impartiality, integrity or operation of the Contest is corrupted or seriously affected by reason of a virus, bug, alteration, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failure or any other reason, the Contest Organizer reserves the right to cancel, modify, extend or suspend the Contest without prior notice.
10. **Limitation of liability: Receipt of entries.** The Contest Organizer and the persons on whose behalf the Contest is held cannot be held liable for entries that are lost, misdirected or late, including as a result of a postal service-related problem or any breakdown, for any reason whatsoever, of the website during the Contest Period, including any damage to an Eligible Entrant's computer or mobile device.

- 11. Limitation of liability: Situation beyond the control.** The Contest Organizer and the persons on whose behalf the Contest is held cannot be held liable in any way whatsoever in the event their inability to act results from a fact or situation beyond their control, or from a strike, lockout or other labour dispute occurring in the organizations or companies whose services are used to hold the Contest.

Contest modification.** The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend this Contest in whole or in part should human intervention or an event take place that could alter or affect the administration, security, impartiality or operation of the Contest as provided for in these contest rules. No liability can be attributed to it.
- 13. Termination of the Contest.** In the event that, for any reason whatsoever, participation in the Contest must be terminated, in whole or in part, before the closing date provided in these rules, the Organizer may, at its sole discretion, award the prizes by choosing from all eligible entries duly received up to the date of the event terminating the Contest.
- 14.** Under no circumstances will the Contest Organizer be required to award more prizes or to award a prize other than in accordance with these contest rules.
- 15. Limitation of liability: Contest entry.** By entering or attempting to enter this Contest, entrants agree to indemnify the Contest Organizer and the persons on whose behalf the Contest is held for any damages that may result from entering or attempting to enter the Contest.
- 16. Communication with Eligible Persons.** No communications, commercial or otherwise, unrelated to this Contest will be sent to Eligible Entrants without their express consent. Any communication or correspondence will be made solely in connection with this Contest, as provided for in these rules, at the Organizer's initiative or to obtain consent to use entries made without purchase or consideration.
- 17. Copyright.** Eligible Entrants agree that the Contest Organizer may use, produce and reproduce, in whole or in part, indefinitely, free of charge, and for internal purposes within Canada, the text submitted for the Contest without mentioning the author's name. Eligible Entrants also agree that the Contest Organizer may translate the text, as needed, without their approval as to the correctness or accuracy of the translation. Eligible Entrants also consent to the Organizer correcting the spelling of the text as needed.
- 18. Personal information.** To enter the Contest, the Contest Organizer must collect, use and disclose personal information about you. For more details, see Desjardins.

By entering the Contest, Eligible Entrants authorize the Contest Organizer or their authorized agents to collect, use and disclose their personal information for the purpose of administering the Contest and awarding prizes in accordance with applicable regulations and their Privacy Policy.

Ownership.** All information and documents related to the Contest, including entry forms and Declaration Forms, technical, technological or operational information and information related to designs, computer systems, software, logos, trademarks and intellectual property are and will remain the exclusive property of the Contest Organizer. None of this information or documentation will be returned to Eligible Persons.
