Desjardins Ontario Credit Union donates \$34,000 to its communities

May 14, 2020 – In light of #GivingTuesdayNow, a global day dedicated to donations and solidarity, which took place on May 5, 2020, Desjardins Ontario Credit Union helped charities working in the communities it serves.

This global day of action has mobilized people from around the world to harness the power of human contact and strengthen local communities in order to provide an emergency response to the unprecedented needs generated by COVID-19.

Desjardins Ontario Credit Union donated \$1,000 to various community organizations. This includes the McCulloch Hospice in Sudbury, the Temiskaming Hospital, the Georgian Bay General Hospital Foundation, the Hamilton Food Share, the Windsor Regional Hospital, La Cité, Saint-Paul University, the Ottawa Community Housing Foundation and *l'ACFO* (Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry). Furthermore, most of these donations were matched by local companies as part of the #GivingTuesdayNow initiative.

On their behalf, I also thank you," said Dr. Wassim Saad from the Windsor Regional Hospital.

In addition, the Credit Union matched the donations received on #GivingTuesdayNow for the Montfort Hospital, for a total of \$25,000. This allowed the Montfort Hospital to raise \$50,800 for COVID-19 emergency funds.
