

## Message from the Caisse Chair

Dear Members,

We're proud to present this review of our caisse's main achievements for fiscal year 2018.

### A governance structure built around you

In order to do what's best for you, our members, we have to get to know you and your needs. This responsibility falls to both the employees who serve you and the directors who represent you on the board.

We believe our board of directors should reflect the diversity of our members. That's why we put together a detailed director job description and issued a call for nominations. The nomination committee then reviewed each nomination we received.

As we announced last year, director roles and responsibilities have been updated to include ethics, professional conduct and cooperation, which were previously the purview of the board of supervision. Again, I'd like to thank all the members who served on the board of supervision for the work they did.

### Here for the community

Because of your commitment to the caisse, we're able to enrich the lives of people and communities. Last year, we distributed \$440,500 through our Community Development Fund and gave \$30,000 in the form of donations and sponsorships.

Along with our financial contributions, our Escouade D (a volunteer squad made up of caisse employees and directors) devoted 520 hours of volunteer work to help support organizations and activities in our region.

Desjardins also used its \$100 million development fund to support and raise awareness of entrepreneurship, education, social responsibility, sustainability, community action and other initiatives that tie in to its socioeconomic mission.

### Desjardins named coolest financial institution

According to Leger's 2018 Youth Study, millennials think Desjardins is the coolest financial institution in Canada! We've made a concerted effort in recent years to offer products and services tailored to young people and to communicate in ways that resonate with them. In 2018, the caisse organized its first-ever youth VIP Desjardins scholarship event, inviting 400 applicants between the ages of 12 and 35 to the Vieux Clocher de Magog for a festive evening. Almost \$15,000 in scholarships was awarded that night.




