REGULATIONS OF THE SRS AWARDS 2020

The Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé (hereinafter "the Caisse") wishes to highlight the work, involvement and various initiatives put forward by the healthcare and social services professionals throughout Québec.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for the SRS Awards (hereinafter referred to as the "Contest"), people submitting projects must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
 - Have a recognized profession related to healthcare and social services;
 - Have your main residence in Quebec;
1. The statement that, in all cases, the persons specified in Article 3 must be excluded at least;
 2. Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of a publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.
 3. The person for whom an advertising contest is held, his employee, his administrator, his representative, his agent or a member of the jury may not participate in this contest.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The SRS Awards are open to anyone working in the health, social services and life sciences network, member and non-member of the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé;
2. The candidate or group of candidates may nominate himself or herself or another colleague or group;
3. The projects submitted must have been carried out within a maximum period of two years preceding the nomination period and must make it possible to assess the impact on the quality of professional practice and the quality of services;
4. The same project may only be proposed for one category;

5. Only applications duly completed using the form available on the Caisse Desjardins du Réseau de la santé website or on the journeesante.ca website, within the required deadlines, will be accepted;
6. Achievements must be explicitly described by answering the questions on the form, in order to allow the jury to make a comprehensive assessment (according to the established evaluation criteria);
7. Nomination forms must be submitted between January 15 and March 1, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. Applications received after this period will not be considered;
8. The individuals or groups selected as finalists will be contacted by phone or email;
9. By submitting your application form, you agree that your text and photo may be published in the 2nd edition of the Revue Santé;
10. A total of \$20,000 will be distributed among the winning projects. Each category (simple, human, modern and efficient) will be accompanied by 3 grants, i.e. \$3,000 for the first places and \$1,500 and \$500 for the second and third places.
11. Travel and accommodation costs related to the Health Day, if applicable, are at the participants' expense;
12. The winning projects will be determined by a jury and will be evaluated according to the eligibility criteria available on the Caisse's website;
13. If no entries are submitted in any of the categories or if there were less than 3 entries in any category, the Caisse reserves the right to redistribute the money among the other winners;
14. The names of the recipients of the SRS Awards, the title of their project and a description of the project will be announced at the Caisse's Annual General Meeting (AGM) on April 23, 2020, to be held at the Club de golf Métropolitain in Anjou. The names and photos of the recipients will also be published on our website, social networks and in our Revue Santé;
15. The winners agree to take a photo and have it used by the Caisse for marketing purposes.
16. Any person participating in the SRS Awards agrees to comply with these rules and the final decisions of the Caisse administering the contest.
17. The Caisse reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend, in whole or in part, this Contest in the event of an incident or any human intervention that may alter or influence the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the Contest as provided in these rules. In such a case, no liability can be attributed to it.
18. Winners release the Caisse from any liability for any damage that may result from their participation in the Contest, acceptance and use of the prize.

19. All registrations and declaration forms may be subject to verification by the Caisse. Those that are incomplete, inaccurate, illegible, mechanically reproduced, mutilated, fraudulent, filed or transmitted late, with an invalid telephone number or otherwise non-compliant, may be rejected and will not be eligible for the prize.
20. The Caisse will not be responsible for lost, misdirected or late entries. Make sure you have received an acknowledgement of receipt within 10 days of sending the form or contact Annick Boismenu at 1 877 522-4773, ext. 7006208.
21. The Caisse shall not assume any liability of any kind whatsoever in the event that its inability to act results from a situation or event beyond its control, a strike, a lockout or any other labour dispute in the establishments or those of companies or organizations related to the holding of the Contest.
22. By accepting the prize, any winner authorizes the Caisse to use, if necessary, his/her name, photograph, image, voice and statement relating to the prize for advertising purposes, without any form of compensation.
23. The personal information collected about participants may be used for various communications that are not related to this Contest. However, the information will not be disclosed to other entities.
24. Registration and declaration forms are the property of the Caisse and will not be returned to participants under any circumstances.
25. If a paragraph of these rules is declared or deemed illegal, unenforceable or invalid by a competent court, then that paragraph shall be considered invalid, but all other paragraphs that are not affected shall be applied within the limits permitted by law.

27. The Contest is subject to all applicable laws.
