


## **DESJARDINS LEADING INDEX**

### The DLI Slid 0.3% in March


The DLI continued to decline in March, but this proved to be less important than the dips recorded over the previous four months (graph 1). The "business" component continued to fall, but at a slower pace (graph 2) thanks to the rebound in the IQ-30 stock index. The households and housing components also shifted into negative territory in March.



### **IMPLICATIONS**

This means that changes in the Quebec economy still need to be monitored, although there appears to be less concern as trade tensions between Canada and the United States ease. Nonetheless, the trade war between our neighbours to the south and China along with the political tensions that persist in many other parts of the world remain risk factors that could further weaken Quebec's economic growth. This growth has slowed compared with 2018 (graph 3) and is expected to remain modest over the next three to six months.
